VFDA's 8 Hour CETP Seminar fulfills the renewal requirements for Propane & Natural Gas Certification. The seminar includes the required two hours of CO/Venting instruction - VTFP-1

- Testing & prevention procedures
- Diagnostics/detection/venting/locations
- Prevention/inspection procedures/reliable operation
- Overall description of CO, how it forms, how to prevent, diagnose and educate
- 4 hours applied to NFPA 54
- 4 hours applied to NFPA 58
- The first 2 hours of review cover the 2005 Vermont Fire Code/NFPA 54 and NFPA 58
- Review of NATIONAL FUEL GAS CODE-2002 Edition (NFPA 58)
- Items covered 8.2 8.3, 8.33, 8.4, all of Chapter 10, Chapter 11 and all of "Annex H" in accordance to the new CO/Venting requirements
- Review of changes to the LPG CODE (NFPA 58) referencing (NFPA 54)

DETAILS:

- **Cancellation** - VFDA reserves the right to *cancel any and all seminars for lack of registrations*. Pre-registered students will be directly notified of cancellations. Since 1990 he has been a consultant and educator to the propane industry, and advises on Inspection/Audits of Fuel Gas facilities for safe installations and operations, Accident Site Investigations and Documentation, Applicable Fuel Gas Standards and Regulations, and Safe Procedures in LP-Gas Operations. Manny has trained LP-Gas operations personnel in 15 states and worked with regulatory authorities in numerous states training and explaining Fuel Gas regulations.
