A complete course on the National and Vermont Oil Burner Standards (Codes) NFPA 31 and NFPA 211. NFPA 31 is the recognized National Standard for Oil Burners, while NFPA 211 is the National Standard for Chimneys and Vents for Oil Fired Equipment. The course will focus on oil burner installation and Code Compliance and will also cover the pertinent sections of NFPA 70, the National Electrical Code.

Each 6 hour session is technically oriented and reviews the Standards from the standpoint of an inspector. Course includes a checklist, a copy of the VT Fire & Safety Code and 4 NORA CEUs/6 VT Oilheat CEUs.

This course is for anyone involved in oilburner installations and service. Features workarounds and methods that provide for Code Compliance, operating safety and proper operation and is ideal for both apprentices and senior technicians, plumbers, sales personnel, managers, Fire Inspectors and anyone else involved in the installation, inspection and servicing of oilheat equipment.
